**1.4.19** To receive and note **apologies for absence**

There were no apologies for absence.

**2.4.19** To receive '**Declarations of Interest**' in items on the agenda

There were no declarations of interest to record.

**3.4.19** **Vacancies on Patrick Brompton Parish Council**

The Clerk outlined that following the recent elections there were two vacancies on the Parish Council and following a period of advertisement four members of the public had expressed interest in joining the Parish Council.

The Clerk outlined that two nominations had been validated, but a further two had not been validated. As only one person who had, had their nomination validated was in attendance at the meeting it was not possible to validate all of the nominations.

The Clerk outlined the options available to Councillors:-

- 1) Defer the matter until 12<sup>th</sup> June to allow all nominations to be validated.
- 2) Determine the matter this evening based on 2 nominations.
- 3) Restart the process.

Councillors agreed to determine the matter based on two valid nominations.

The Clerk declared Brian Whithead and Richard Darbishire elected.

At the conclusion of the item two members of the public joined the meeting, including Mr Darbishire.

Following an explanation of the procedure Mr Darbishire accepted nomination and election to the Parish Council.
