## **SUNFLOWER Russian Giant**

Easy to grow and a giant in sunflowers, growing up to 3m (10ft) tall if given plenty of room. This variety is most eye-catching, boasting huge yellow flowers up to 30cm (12in) in diameter. Birds love the seeds and will feed from them in the autumn.

SOWING INSTRUCTIONS: Sow thinly, 12mm (1/2 in) deep in drills 45cm (18in) apart in well cultivated soil which has been raked to a fine tilth. Germination usually takes about 21 days. When large enough to handle, thin out seedlings to 45cm (18in) apart. Alternatively, sunflowers can be sown indoors in late winter/early spring. Sow individually into 7.5cm (3in) pots at a temperature of 20-30C (68-86F). Grow on in good light, and plant out when all risk of frost has passed.

The ripe seeds make a tasty snack, while the fresh green flower buds can be harvested before they open and cooked in a butter sauce to create a unique side dish. Please write to T&M for a free leaflet on edible flowers.
